

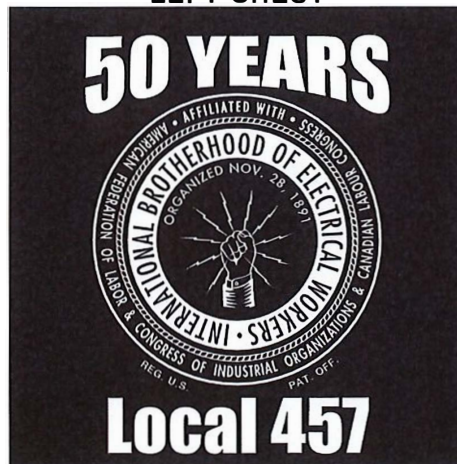

Meriden in the State of Connecticut

This Local Union shall be known as Local Union No. 457 and shall have jurisdiction as defined in the approved Bylaws of the Local Union.

This Charter grants to this local Union all powers delegated by the Constitution of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers. It may be retained as long as five members in good standing comply with all the requirements of the Constitution of the Brotherhood, unless reclaimed by the International Union.
